



The first image of P-22 was captured on February 12, 2012, at 9:15 p.m., by a camera trap placed by wildlife biologist Miguel Ordeñana, who at the time was collecting footage as part of the Griffith Park Connectivity Study. The remotely triggered camera was one of many used to study medium- and large-sized mammals as they moved to and from Griffith Park and the surrounding area. It was a thrill for Miguel to discover the photo of a puma walking along the trail that runs above the Ford Amphitheatre.
